Please turn in solutions for the following problems:

- Compute each real integral using complex integration techniques:

$$(1) \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{1}{x^6 + 1} dx$$

$$(2) \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{x^2}{(x^2 + 4)(x^2 + 9)} dx$$

$$(3) \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{x \sin(x)}{x^2 + 4} dx$$

$$(4) \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{\cos(4x)}{(x^2 + 1)^2} dx$$

$$(5) \int_{-\infty}^{\infty} \frac{x^2 \cos(x)}{(x^2 + 1)(x^2 + 16)} dx$$

$$(6) \int_0^{\infty} \frac{\sqrt{x}}{(x^2 + 1)^2} dx$$

$$(7) \int_0^{2\pi} \frac{2}{\cos(x) + 2} dx$$

$$(8) \int_0^{2\pi} \frac{1}{5 + 4 \sin(x)} dx$$
