

Postdoctoral Position in transition metal mediated catalysis at West Virginia University

A postdoc position is available to work in the area of transition metal catalysis related to developing new synthetic methodologies and asymmetric catalysis. A Ph. D. in synthetic organic chemistry is required, with ability to contribute effectively to methodology development and/or photo catalysis.
